2	Support Pedagogical Innovation and Research on Learning	 Continuing development work (e.g., course emailer). Engaging with IPS on Core Canvas backlog items. Working on spring HarvardX Hybrid pilot. With VPAL, validating Canvas data in support of research. 	GREEN
3	Establish Harvard Teaching and Learning Community	 Engaging with Schools at multiple levels. Hosting December Canvas Governance Group meeting. Hosting December Coffee & Canvas. Participating in HILT's TLC meetings and events. 	GREEN
4	Cultivate Developer Community	 Hosting January academic developer meeting. Consulting with Schools on LTI development. Working with student developer on AskUp project. 	GREEN

Provide **multiple platforms** – with ability to re-use content, interoperability and extensibility across platforms, and access to data – to support Harvard's residential and online teaching and learning needs



Platform Extensibility / Interoperability via LTI

- LTI = learning tools interoperability
- Both Canvas and edX accept LTI
- TLT has made edX an LTI provider (creating ability to bring edX content into Canvas)
- Many third-party LTI tools available
- Instructure uses LTI tools as part of the Canvas platform
- 7+ schools have built ~21 LTI tools
- TLT consults on LTI development
- Developer community emerging

All Course iSites should be migrated to Canvas for future availability/access. Canvas site can remain unpublished.



July 1, 2016

All Course iSites will enter read-only mode.

No changes can be made to Course iSites after this date.



August 1, 2017

Course iSites will be retired.

No access to Course iSites past this date.
